English breakfast

A traditional blend of teas originating from Assam, Ceylon and Kenya

Earl grey

This tea combines precious black leaves infused not with pure bergamot oil

Organic Fog Green

Green tea with a very aromatic and sweet flavour

Gardenia

A Japanese green tea is added to a selection of green and white teas from China

Assam 2nd Flush

The 2nd Flush (or pick) offers an exceptional grade and with a little extra depth

Darjeeling 1st Flush

A new breed of organic teas. The 1st Flush is when the buds are fresh and vibrant

Lapsang Souchong

Single larger souchong leaves, this tea is roasted before being smoked over resin rich pine wood

Nepalese Ruby

Intense fruit, spice and liquorice notes that produce a very pronounced finish in the mouth

Rwandan Rukeri

The Rukeri garden was founded only 50 years ago, producing traditional tea. Spicy and fruity tea

Malawi White

Combines the delicacy of white peony, with notes of caramel and smooth honeysuckle

Yellow Mountain

Green tea produced in south eastern interior Anhui province of China

Ceylon Orange Pekoe



Clean, brisk taste, 'Orange Pekoe' refers to the grade, an unbroken whole leaf tea with long wiry leaves

Iron Goddess of Mercy

Is incredibly light, with the aroma of orchids. The balls open out into huge green leaves

Chai of Sri Lanka

Cinnamon, ginger, cardamom, clove, pink and bruised pepper
